

Dear colleagues,

Welcome to the Fourth Nordic LHC Physics Workshop to be held in Stockholm jointly organised by the Departments of Physics at Stockholm University and the Royal Institute of Technology.

The workshop will start at noon Friday 23 November and continue through Saturday 24 November 2001. The programme is foreseen to contain reports from the established working groups as well as presentations of new studies. Also a session on GRID/computing is planned. The programme will be outlined together with the working group convenors and will be posted on the web page as it develops. If you wish to make a presentation, please indicate the content in the registration form.

The workshop will be preceded by a NorFa training course starting on Thursday 22 November and ending at noon Friday 23 November. The course will be devoted to studies of supersymmetry. The Polish theorists Bohdan Grzadkowski, Jan Kalinowski and Janusz Rosiek will visit Stockholm during the week of the workshop and they will contribute with lectures. The lectures will start at a basic level, motivating SUSY from a theoretical point of view. Results from searches for SUSY at LEP as well as at the Tevatron run I will be presented. Prospects for SUSY searches/measurements at the Tevatron run II and at LHC will be given.

The Workshop venue will be the newly built Stockholm Center for Physics, Astronomy and Biotechnology (SCFAB).
